WGXC is a community-run media project, re-envisioning radio as an innovative platform for local participation. Our inclusive programming will connect diverse voices, and distribute information across the public spectrum in New York's Greene and Columbia Counties.

Thanks for filling this out. We can't promise we can get you a show, but we will try, and there will be many fill-in shows, and rotating shows, and regular changes for contributions. Approved shows will be reviewed by station staff, who will also provide helpful suggestions. Occasionally shows will be taken off, usually just for a brief period to give another show a chance. But we need to fill 168 hours a week, so there will be many slots available. Don't expect to hear anything definitive until May 2010, although we will be contacting everyone who applies with additional questions.

What type of radio show would you like to do?

What times, and days of the week, are you available to do a show? Do you envision a weekly or a monthly show? Would you also consider doing segments in the morning or afternoon drive-time shows?

If there isn't space on the schedule for a regular show for you, are you interested in being one of a group of stand-by DJs, who do shows on an irregular basis, often on Saturdays?

Can you describe any other community groups, or arts groups, you work with in Greene or Columbia counties? Any other associations we should know about, or past or current experience in radio you want to tell us about?
